The D2/IDP Research Fellowship

- Length: **July 2026 – March 2027**
- Time commitment: at least 400hrs total on your project, spread over 32 weeks (average 12.5h/wk but ranging from 8h to 20h/wk)
- Expectations:
 - Obtain IRB approval by July 1
 - Attend regular research update meetings (1x/quarter)
 - Attend the abstract writing and scientific poster workshops
 - Present your work at RCED

Funding

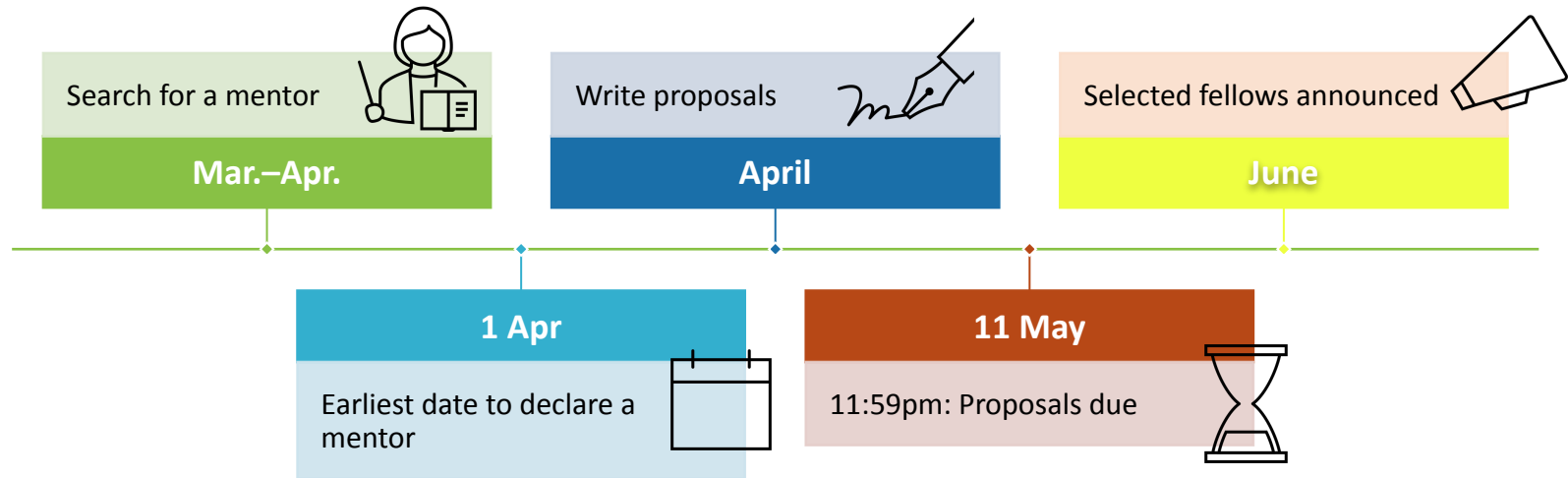


\$1,500 stipend



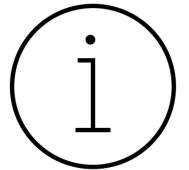
Up to \$500 for Research Expenses

Application Requirements

- CV or resumé
- Letter of Support from mentor
- 4-page proposal (plus cover page and references)
- Copy of submitted IRB application (if required)
- Submission instructions TBA

Breakdown of the Research Proposal

I. Cover page

- Title
- Your name and email
- Your mentor's name and email
- Date of submission

II. Research Proposal (Limit to 4 pages PDF, 1400 words!!)

- Specific Aims
- Research Strategy
 - Significance
 - Innovation
 - Approach
- Additional Information:
 - IRB approval or IRB submission documentation (if needed)

III. Literature Cited

IV. Letter of support from your PI
